New Student Enrollment Procedure

Eligibility and Application:

- Be at least 15 years old as of the first day of the quarter
- Apply online for admissions to Highline College at admissions@highline.edu
- Activate your MyHighline email account
- Visit Highline's Placement and Testing Center to assess English and Math course placement if needed for course pre-requisite.
- Complete the New Student Orientation

To Register: Schedule an appointment with a High School Programs advisor during open registration. Bring this form to your appointment.

Costs: You pay for tuition, textbooks, student center fee, and applicable fees. See our website for tuition rates and fees. If you are 19 years or older and a Washington State resident you may qualify for reduced tuition.

Courses: 5 college credits = 1 high school credit
