New Student Enrollment Procedure

Apply: You must be at least 16 years old as of the first day of the quarter. Complete this authorization form and a Highline application. Take the COMPASS assessment.

To Register: Bring this form and meet with a High School Programs advisor in Building 6 during open registration.

Courses: 5 college credits = 1 high school credit

Costs: A nonrefundable application fee.

Tuition is based on the number of college credits registered. See the current quarterly for tuition rates. If you are 19 years or older and a Washington State resident you may qualify for reduced tuition. Tuition is due at the time you register. You will also need to pay for books, student center fees, special course fees, and parking.
